

The top behaviors of concern in the waste industry turn out to be related to driving fundamentals. Driver distractions like cell phone use and eating in the cab are noticed

commonly. Also, basics like following distance, rolling stops, and speed violations all rank highly as a percentage of the total events recorded.


MOST PREVALENT DRIVING BEHAVIORS



Delving a bit deeper into the data, Lytx® examined collisions per 100 vehicles in service among the variety of vehicles in service for the waste industry. The collision rate varies from 5.1 for Roll-offs to 14.3 for multi-tanker vehicles. The high collision rate observed in light duty trucks is highly illuminating in light of a recent article published by WasteAge.com and written by Bruce Hooker of R.F. Mattei and Associates (an insurance services company). In discussing fleet safety programs, Hooker notes that, ancillary vehicles often are overlooked in the implementation of these (collection vehicle) safety programs. He further states: “The ancillary fleet includes

all of the vehicles owned or operated by a waste company besides the actual collection vehicles. Generally, this consists of vehicles that do not require a commercial driver’s license (CDL), such as service units; supervisor vehicles; pickup trucks used to service missed stops or to run errands; company cars for officers, sales people and managers; and even personal autos owned by employees, if those vehicles are used for company business. Accidents involving the ancillary fleet have led to significant liability claims against many waste companies, and fleet safety programs need to address this exposure.”
