

Why Safety ROI Isn't a One-Year Metric

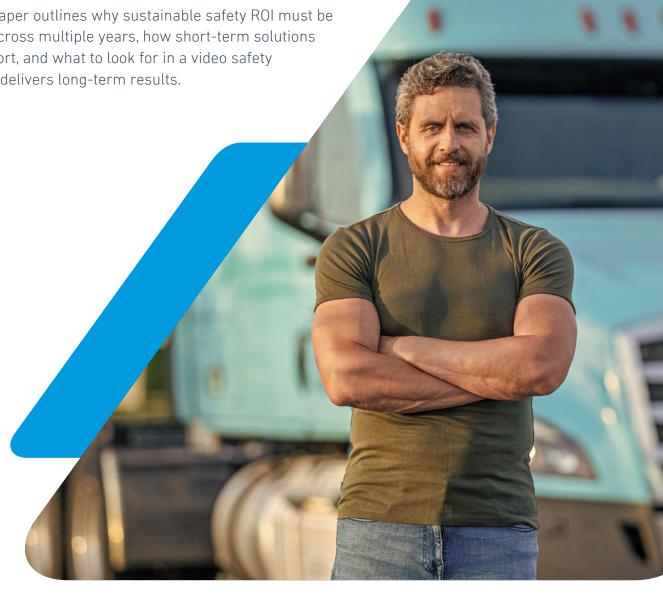




Executive Summary

Fleet safety programs are often evaluated by their return on investment after the first year. But this short-term lens can be critically misleading. While some video safety systems boast impressive results in year one, largely driven by the novelty of being monitored, many fail to deliver ongoing or meaningful performance improvements. Without systems in place to build and reinforce lasting driver behavior change, initial gains erode, and claims costs rise again.

This white paper outlines why sustainable safety ROI must be measured across multiple years, how short-term solutions often fall short, and what to look for in a video safety system that delivers long-term results.





The False Promise of Year-One ROI

Some video safety vendors promise—and even deliver—quick wins in year one. That's not inherently a bad thing. When drivers know they're being monitored, risky behaviors like speeding or distracted driving often drop rapidly. But this "surveillance effect" is short-lived. In many cases, these improvements plateau or even backslide in the second or third year.

The reason? Behavioral change hasn't actually occurred. While drivers may temporarily improve, old habits will return if don't they understand and internalize safer driving habits.

Some drivers even find ways to "game the system", essentially finding workarounds to achieve green scores without making any driving or behavior changes.

THE COST OF UNSUSTAINED GAINS

When behaviors regress, the consequences are costly:

- · Driver behavior remains unchanged.
- Insurance premiums creep back up.
- · Claims costs rise again.
- Collision frequency returns to baseline.
- Your team loses trust in the system.

Fleets that chase short-term ROI may find themselves back where they started, or worse, within 18 to 24 months. And by then, the cost of switching to a more effective solution is compounded by lost time and stalled progress. lytx
