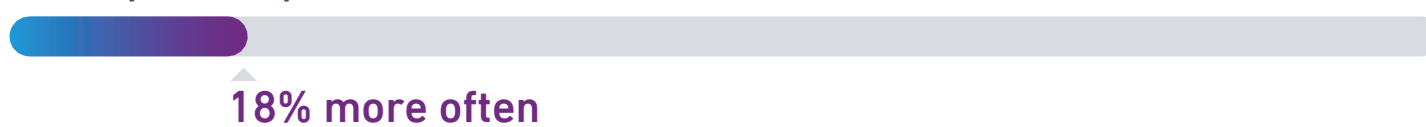
TRANSIT FLEETS VS. ALL INDUSTRIES

Behaviors from transit industry fleets benchmarked against behavior averages of all other Lytx-covered industries

Near Collision and Near Collision (unavoidable)



*Incomplete Stop



Food/Drink Observed



*Late Response: When a driver was not distracted, yet responded late and abruptly to a readily visible risky situation ahead

*Incomplete Stop: When a driver was below 5 mph and the vehicle did not come to a complete stop or a stop at a stop sign or while turning right at a red light

*Following Distance: When the distance to the vehicle directly ahead was approximately 1.5 seconds and not increasing for at least 4 consecutive seconds

*Failed to Stop: When a driver failed to stop at a stop sign or his/her speed remained above 5 mph
